Saade elected vice president of the Colorado Municipal League's Executive Board

DENVER, Colo. – Friday, July 10, 2026 – Breckenridge Council Member Carol Saade was elected vice president of the Colorado Municipal League (CML) Executive Board at CML's 104th Annual Conference that occurred in Westminster on June 24. Saade will serve as vice president through June 2027 and represents the Board's small population category (less than 8,000).

CML is a nonprofit, non-partisan organization representing and serving Colorado's cities and towns: 270 towns and municipalities are members of the League. The [21-member Board](#) is responsible for the overall finances, management, and policy direction of the League.

Saade previously served on the CML Board as the treasurer/secretary. She has served on the Breckenridge Town Council since 2020 and brings a strong commitment to municipal service, including advocating for local control and good governance practices. She has a deep understanding of the needs of resort communities with tourism-driven economies. Since Breckenridge has been a leader in advancing housing and environmental goals, and other community-driven initiatives, she recognizes the importance, and positive impact, of local solutions for each community.

Saade has lived in Breckenridge since 2010 and holds a degree in economics from James Madison University. Her professional and civic experience includes international policy work with the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development in Geneva, Switzerland, and years of community leadership in Colorado.

She started her municipal service on the Breckenridge Open Space Advisory Committee and has since served on the boards of numerous community organizations. She is a founding member of Mountain Dreamers, a nonprofit dedicated to supporting and elevating immigrant voices in mountain communities. She has also mentored first-generation college students through Colorado Mountain College since 2016.
