GOVERNOR POLIS TO ADDRESS MUNICIPAL OFFICIALS ON FEB. 14

February 7, 2019, Denver, CO – Gov. Jared Polis will address municipal officials from across the state at the Colorado Municipal League's annual legislative workshop on **Thurs, Feb. 14** at **10:00 a.m.** The event will be held at the History Colorado Center, 1200 Broadway, Denver.

Colorado's municipal officials will gather at this daylong workshop to discuss key municipal issues before the 2019 General Assembly and CML legislative priorities. A 12:00pm session featuring Speaker of the House KC Becker, Senate Minority Whip Ray Scott, and House Minority Leader Patrick Neville will focus on caucus priorities and issues of municipal interest.

Additional sessions for attendees will take a closer look at Colorado's transportation and transit challenges, as well as how Colorado will address sales tax issues following last year's landmark U.S. Supreme Court decision in *South Dakota vs. Wayfair*. A session led by one of the top lobbyists for the National League of Cities will examine municipal issues at the federal level.
