Westminster mayor pro tem appointed as CML Policy Committee chair

Sept. 21, 2020 – Denver, CO - City of Westminster Mayor Pro Tem Anita Seitz was selected by CML Executive Board President Bob Widner, Centennial city attorney, to chair the Colorado Municipal League's Policy Committee. The term begins immediately and lasts through June 2021.
