### **Golden Mayor Weinberg elected president of the Colorado Municipal League's Executive Board**

DENVER, Colo. – Friday, July 10, 2026 – Golden Mayor Laura Weinberg was elected president of the Colorado Municipal League (CML) Executive Board at CML's 104th Annual Conference that occurred in Westminster on June 24. Weinberg will serve as president through June 2027 and represents the Board's medium population category (8,000 to 59,999). She was reelected to the Board at the conference, and her two-year term runs through June 2028.

CML is a nonprofit, non-partisan organization representing and serving Colorado's cities and towns: 270 towns and municipalities are members of the League. The [21-member Board](#) is responsible for the overall finances, management, and policy direction of the League.

Weinberg has been on the Board since 2021 and previously served as vice president. She has served the Golden community since 2011 as a board member, city councilor, and now mayor. She holds a bachelor's degree in Public Policy from Brown University and a master's degree in Business Administration from University of Denver. Weinberg had a management career in technology for the financial services industry, and now, she and her husband are currently small business owners. She has spent years volunteering in the community for various organizations. Not only is she president of CML, but also she represents Golden as an active member on local, regional, and national boards, such as the Metro Mayors Caucus and the National League of Cities' Human Development Committee.
