Ended June 15, 2020

Brief Background:

- Legislature temporarily adjourned from March 14-May 25.
- Many pieces of legislation discussed today were passed in the three weeks the legislature reconvened.
- The State faced a nearly \$7 billion shortfall over the next two fiscal years.
