The position assists the General Counsel in advocating municipal positions through amicus curiae briefing in state and federal appellate courts for the benefit of the League's members. Additionally, as assigned by the General Counsel, the Associate Counsel will: author articles, summaries, or other relevant communications to members on advocacy issues; develop and maintain relationships with members and others; help develop the curricula for the continuing legal education sessions at the CML annual conference and fall attorneys' seminar; assist the legislative advocacy team by drafting and analyzing proposed legislation, ballot initiatives and referenda, and administrative regulations; and research and respond to inquiries.

Our successful candidate must possess high moral and ethical standards and be dedicated to the needs of Colorado municipalities and their respective legal counsel. This position requires a Juris Doctor degree and admission to the Colorado Bar Association. At least two years of legal experience required, and experience with Colorado municipal law strongly preferred.
