WEBINAR – CIVIL INFRASTRUCTURE RESILIENCE: ASSESSING CLIMATE CHANGE VULNERABILITY, ADAPTATION, AND RISK

Presented by Dr. Paul S. Chinowsky, Resilient Analytics™ founder and co-director and University of Colorado Civil, Environmental, and Architectural Engineering professor

The rapidly growing recognition of the detrimental impacts of climate change, particularly on the built environment and the consequential implications for society, calls for more robust and quantitative means of measuring impacts and planning for the future. The potential severity of climate change's impact on civil infrastructure in the near and longer-term future requires that the infrastructure policy and planning disciplines integrate actionable climate resilience planning into currently used decision and management frameworks. Climate change compounds existing issues and raises new questions, including changing temporal elements, higher levels of uncertainty, and an increased urgency to address vulnerabilities that will be further exploited by a changing future climate.

This webinar will present methods for assessing the full range of potential climate change impacts, measures to assess vulnerability, opportunities for robust adaptation investment strategies, and techniques to reduce risk, increase sustainability, and transfer knowledge about climate change to decision makers.
