3	AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3-1-1, B.R.C. 1981, BY ADDING THE TERMS "MARKETPLACE," "MARKETPLACE FACILITATOR," "MARKETPLACE SELLER" AND
4	"MULTICHANNEL SELLER" TO THE DEFINITION OF "RETAILER" AND DEFINING EACH INDIVIDUALLY; AND
5	SETTING FORTH RELATED DETAILS.

7	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOULDER,
8	COLORADO:
9	Section 1. The definition of "Retailer" in Section 3-1-1, "Definitions," B.R.C. 1981, is
10	amended to read as follows:
11	3-1-1 Definitions.
<ul><li>12</li><li>13</li></ul>	Retailer or Vendor means any person selling, leasing, renting, or granting a license to use tangible personal property or services at retail. The terms Retailer or Vendor shall include, but areis not limited to, any: (1) Auctioneer; (2) Salesperson, representative, peddler or canvasser, who
14 15	makes sales as a direct or indirect agent of or obtains such property or services sold from a dealer, distributor, supervisor or employer; (3) Charitable organization or governmental entity which makes sales of <i>Tangible personal property</i> to the public, notwithstanding the fact that the
16	merchandise sold may have been acquired by gift or donation or that the proceeds are to be used for charitable or governmental purposes; (4) <i>Retailer-contractor</i> , when acting in the capacity of a seller of building supplies, construction materials, and other <i>Tangible personal property</i> ; and (5)
17	Marketplace facilitator, marketplace seller, or multichannel seller.
18	Section 2. Amend Section 3-1-1, "Definitions," B.R.C. 1981, to add the following new
19	definitions:
20	3-1-1 - Definitions.
21	<u>Marketplace</u> means a physical or electronic forum, including, but not limited to, a store, a booth, an internet website, a catalog, or a dedicated sales software application, where tangible
22	personal property, taxable products, or taxable services are offered for sale.
23	Marketplace Facilitator means a person who:
24	(a) Contracts with a marketplace seller or multichannel seller to facilitate for consideration, regardless of whether or not the consideration is deducted as fees

1	from the transaction, the sale of the marketplace seller's tangible personal property, products, or services through the person's marketplace;
2	(b) Engages directly or indirectly, through one or more affiliated persons, in
3	transmitting or otherwise communicating the offer or acceptance between a purchaser and the marketplace seller or multichannel seller; or
4	(c) Either directly or indirectly, through agreements or arrangements with third parties, collects payment from the purchaser on behalf of the seller.
5	Marketplace Facilitator does not include a person that exclusively provides internet
6	advertising services or lists products for sale, and that does not otherwise meet this definition.
7	<u>Marketplace Seller means a person, regardless of whether or not the person is engaged in business in the city, which has an agreement with a marketplace facilitator and offers for sale tangible personal property, products, or services through a marketplace owned, operated, or</u>
8	controlled by a marketplace facilitator.
9	<u>Multichannel Seller means a retailer that offers for sale tangible personal property,</u> commodities, or services through a marketplace owned, operated, or controlled by a marketplace
10	facilitator, and through other means.
11	
12	Section 3. If any provision of this ordinance, or the application of such provision to any
13	person or circumstance, is held to be unconstitutional, then the remainder of this ordinance, and
14	the application of the provisions of such to any person or circumstance, shall not be affected
15	thereby.
	Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective on the first day of the month that is at
16	least 30 days after date of its adoption.
17	Section 5. This ordinance is necessary to protect the public health, safety, and welfare of
18	the residents of the city and covers matters of local concern.
19	Section 6. The city council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title
20	
21	only and orders that copies of this ordinance be made available in the office of the city clerk for
22	public inspection and acquisition.
