HALL SELECTED BY COLORADO MUNICIPAL LEAGUE EXECUTIVE BOARD PRESIDENT FOR BUDGET, AUDIT AND MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

August 8, 2019 –Colorado Municipal League (CML) Executive Board President Elizabeth (Liz) Hensley, Alamosa mayor pro tem, recently selected Dale Hall, Greeley councilmember and CML Executive Board member, for CML’s Budget, Audit and Management (BAM) Committee. Hall joins three other appointees and two automatic appointees, who are Board executive officers, on the six-member committee.

The BAM Committee plays a critical role in the League’s governance, and is responsible for reviewing and making recommendations to the Executive Board on issues related to the budget, audit, personnel policies, professional contracts, investment authority, membership dues schedule, and staff compensation ranges and fringe benefits.
